

NOTICE OF APPLICATION

On September 29, 2017, Energy West Montana, Inc. (“EWM”) and Cut Bank Gas Company (“CBGC”) filed a joint request to the Montana Public Service Commission (“Commission”) for authority to increase and establish natural gas delivery service rates for each utility’s service territory (“Joint Application”). The changes proposed in the Joint Application may affect the rates for services you receive from EWM.

EWM’s rates were last established by the Commission in 2011. Since that time, EWM’s cost of providing service has increased. As demonstrated in the Joint Application, EWM’s current rates are no longer just and reasonable, as they do not allow EWM to recover its cost of providing service, nor do they provide EWM an opportunity to earn a fair and reasonable return on its investments. Based on the historical test year included with the Joint Application, EWM has a revenue deficiency of \$1,526,960. EWM has asked the Commission to approve increased rates to recover this deficiency. EWM also proposes to implement a new rate mechanism to allow it to accelerate the replacement of higher risk infrastructure and recover its actual capital investment without requiring more frequent rate case proceedings.

In West Yellowstone, the effect of the proposed increase in rates is as follows:
